1.0 How to Read This Document

The release description is separated into several sections. The purpose of the document is to outline the test recommendation on whether or not to proceed with the next planned step in deployment, whether that is to an acceptance test phase or to production. Additionally, the release details are outlined in the other sections. The major sections and their purpose are outlined below:

- **Delivered Functionality** – All requests scheduled for the target point release.

- **Recommendation** – This section summarizes the recommendation by the test organization on whether to proceed or not. The recommendation will prompt the reader whether it is necessary to read in-depth further in the document to make a business decision to proceed, although it is always recommended to read the entire document before proceeding. The options for recommendation are:
 - Release with No Issues
 - Release with Minor Issues
 - Release with Major Issues
 - Do Not Release
