

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

What is the Migrant Student Information Exchange?

MSIX

- Web-based portal that **links** States' migrant student record databases
- Facilitates the national exchange of migrant students' demographic (COE), educational, and health information among the States
- Provides a consolidated national view
- Contains the minimum data elements to support the proper enrollment, grade and course placement, and accrual of credits for migrant children
- Does not replace existing State migrant student information systems


Ensure the use of the consolidated migrant student record for the purposes of enrollment, placement, and accrual of credits of migrant students


Produce national data on the migrant population

State Implementation Status




Currently, there are approximately 267,000 Category 1 student records with at least demographic information across all grades.


Recent MSIX Accomplishments

- Maintained over **99%** Production availability for MSIX
- Supported **4** states to provide Phase II (Assessment) data – Hawaii, Iowa, Georgia, New Mexico
- Supported **6** states to provide Phase III (Course History) data – Hawaii, Iowa, California, Georgia, New Mexico, Oklahoma
- Ingested REACTS data into MSIX website
- Enhanced MSIX Consolidated Migrant Student Record
- Deployed **4** functional releases, addressing **33** enhancement requests and incidents
- Presented at NASDME and ESCORT ID&R Conferences
- Conducted **3** end-user webinars (2 via REACTS)
(Missed Enrollment and Grade Retention Reports)
- MSIX NPRM was published on December 27, 2013


MSIX: A Valuable Tool Supporting ID&R



Effective Recruiting Practices

- Determine eligibility
- Find information for student placement
- Identify special needs
- Identify points of contact for additional information

MSIX: A Valuable Tool Supporting ID&R




Identify and Expand ID&R Network

- Anticipate students moving into your school district
- Notify others upon students leaving your school district
- Facilitate growing your ID&R network

MSIX: A Valuable Tool Supporting ID&R

ID&R Planning



- Missed Enrollment Report to identify potential recruiting areas
- Mobility Reports to reveal trends in inter-state moves
- Enrollments in Multiple States Report to reveal moving trends to support ID&R planning

Effective Recruiting Practices



Scenario 1

One of your migrant families tells you about new migrant families and youths in the community.

You are only provided with the parents' first and last name, as well as other personal information.

How can you obtain more details about these families?

Recruiter

You have completed the family/student interview and want to validate the information they provided you

MSIX Practice

Prior to the initial interview, perform a *Student Search* with the details provided to see if the family or youth is or has been in the MEP.

Effective Recruiting Practices (cont'd)



Basic Search supports the most common searches

- Student Name
- Student Date of Birth
- Student Gender
- MSIX ID
- State Student ID
- State



Advanced Search provides additional search parameters


- *All Basic Search parameters, plus...*
- Student Last Name 2
- Student Suffix
- Female Parent Name
- Male Parent Name
- Student Birth Location
- Multiple Birth Flag

Effective Recruiting Practices (cont'd)



- **Only specific user roles have access to student search functionality**
 - Primary Users
 - Secondary Users
 - Data Administrators
- **Some basic information must be provided for each search**
 - Student Name (First, Middle, or Last)
 - MSIX ID
 - State Student ID
- **Searches can be “Partial” or “Exact”**
 - Partial searches include a “Wild Card” at the end of each search string
 - A Partial search for “Juan” can yield results such as “Juan”, “Juanita”, and “Juana”
 - Exact searches only search for the text specified
 - An Exact search for “Juan” will only yield results of “Juan”


Scenario

- One of your migrant families is moving to another state.
- How can you help ensure the student(s) of that family are identified by the receiving State?

MSIX Practice

- Utilize the *Send Email Notification* function at the bottom of the student's *Consolidated Record View* to notify the family's destination state.


Scenario #1

- How do you identify those students who have yet to enroll?

MSIX Practice

- Use Missed Enrollments Report to identify students have yet to enroll

ID&R Planning (cont'd)





MSIX Practice #1

- Use the MSIX General Move To Report to analyze student movement trends, understand the number of students that move out of the user's state at different times of the year, and which states most students move to.

ID&R Planning (cont'd)



Scenario #2

- You and your ID&R team are planning for your recruiting season for the school year. You want to proactively identify areas and movement timing of migrant families

MSIX Practice #2


- Use the Enrollments in Multiple States Report to allow recruiters to view students that have enrollment records in other states in addition to their own.
- Key Point: Recruiters can gain insights on interstate relationships regarding migrant students.
